All runs associated with the Stevenage & District Motorcycle Club are organised and led by individual members of the Club on a voluntary basis; they are not officially sanctioned or endorsed by any authority of the club. Neither the Club nor any members takes any responsibility for the acts or omissions of anyone riding in the group.

If you chose to join a group ride, you and your motorcycle must be fully road legal and you ride at your own risk, taking full personal responsibility for your own riding. You must ride:

- as an individual
- at your own pace
- at your own skill level
- covered by your own insurance

We don't run a regimented system to keep everyone together on most of our group rides but with bigger groups, we sometime operate the "drop off" system:

- The group will be led by a S&DMCC rider, generally wearing an orange & green hi-vis vest.
- Another S&DMCC rider will be at the tail end of the group, usually wearing a distinctive BLUE hi-vis vest.
- Their places will not change throughout the ride.
- At each junction, the rider immediately behind the leader stops as close as possible to where the leader indicates (ensuring it is safe to do so), marks the junction and indicates the route to the rest of the group.
- All other riders pass that marker except the tail ender.
- The marker then re-joins the group in front of the BLUE hi-vis tail ender.
- Markers may be placed before and/or after a junction.
- In the unlikely event a junction is not marked, go straight on.
- If you want to leave the group you should pull in to the left in a safe, visible position and wave other riders past.

Please ride responsibly and comply with road traffic legislation.
