- 5. Entry fees will only be refunded in the event of a postponement or abandonment.
- 6. All vehicles must be in possession of a current Road Fund License, MOT and Insurance in compliance with the Roads Traffic Act.

<u>Class 2</u> Post Vintage Solo, machines manufactured between 01/01/1931 & 31/12/1944

<u>Class 4</u> Classic Solo, machines manufactured between 01/01/1961 & 31/12/1975

<u>Class 5</u> Modern Classic Solo, machines manufactured between 01/01/1976 & 31/12/1990

<u>Class 6</u> Nearly There Classic Solo, machines manufactured between 01/01/1991 & 31/12/2005
